





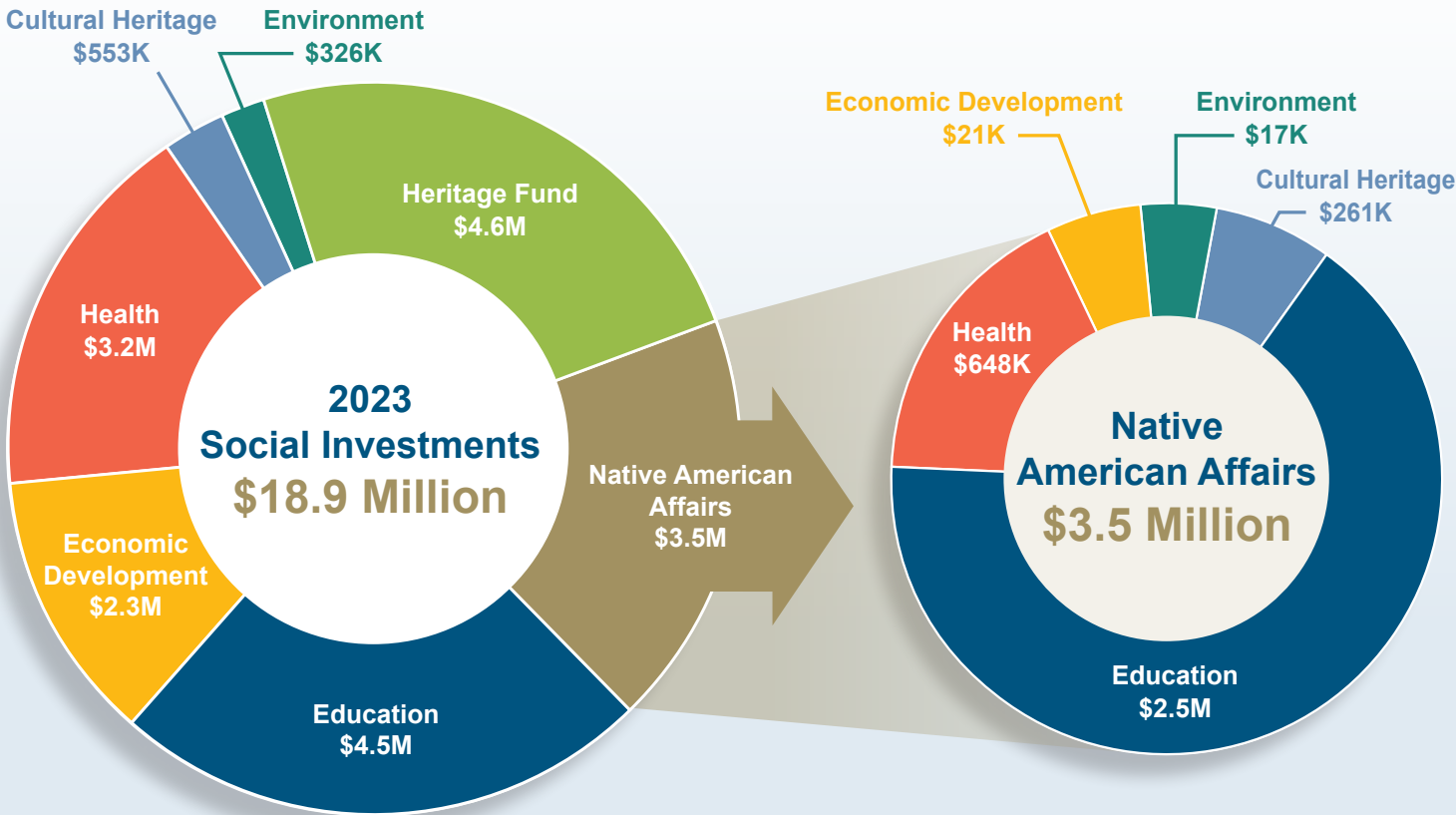

CDCs are advisory groups of local stakeholders that nominate community development projects for NGM funding consideration, helping to ensure that funded projects meet the needs of local communities.

PROJECT HIGHLIGHTS



NGM Early Learning Center

Winnemucca – The Winnemucca Boys and Girls Club opened the NGM Early Learning Center in September 2023. NGM invested \$1.5 million to allow for the purchase and renovation

of an existing building housing the new center. The center can serve 80-90 children and has extended operating hours (4 am to 8 pm) to serve the mining community. In total, NGM has invested \$4.5 million to develop childcare centers in three areas where we operate (Elko, Spring Creek and Winnemucca).

Battle Mountain Depot and Mining Museum

Battle Mountain – NGM invested \$250,000 to support the expansion of the Battle Mountain Museum. The expansion allows more room for mining education, space for larger displays and a pavilion offering added space for education and fundraising events, as well as a community rental venue. Currently under construction with completion slated for Fall 2024.

Great Basin Children's Advocacy Center (GBCAC)



Elko – The center provides a place for a coordinated response to child abuse cases. Social services, medical professionals, law enforcement partners and more are housed under one roof to serve children and families who have experienced abuse in Elko, Eureka, White Pine, and Lander counties. NGM invested \$200,000 over two years to support the cost of mental health services provided by GBCAC. The center is now open and has provided services and support to 45 children.

Downtown Development Infrastructure Phase I Project

West Wendover – Project supported infrastructure development in the downtown area, making it more attractive for mixed use (commercial and high density residential). NGM investment was \$400,000 out of a \$7 million project budget.

Senior Center

Wells – Construction of a new Senior Center in Wells is underway and will be complete in Fall 2024. NGM committed to investing \$300,000 over two years (2023 & 2024) towards the Center's estimated \$1.9 million cost. Funding will provide a safe space for seniors to socialize, participate in organized activities and receive meals.
