TRANSITIONING TECHS.

If you're a transitioning military technician, Dustin Stout might be your ticket to a great civilian career. Stout, 31, is an active duty technician recruiter for the recruiting firm Orion International.

COMING SOON. He travels to bases to help military technicians prepare resumes, perform mock interviews and educate them on the industries and positions that may be a good fit for them.

BEEN THERE, DONE THAT. He took the same path from the Navy, where he operated and maintained the nuclear reactor's mechanical systems on Los Angeles class submarines. As rewarding as it was, there was someone who needed him more. "I chose to separate from the Navy to help take care of my daughter with special needs," he says.

RECRUITED TO RECRUIT. Stout enlisted Orion and attended one of their hiring conferences. There an Orion manager recognized the recruiting ability Stout had picked up from his shore tour on recruiting duty and offered him a job with a competitive salary.

THIS IS TOUGH. The biggest challenge for Stout is getting veterans to understand that not all companies are hiring. "I hear from veterans all the time that they have connections within a company and plan to work there," he says. "The reality of it is that if they do not have a position open, then there is no job."
